Dear Parent / Carer,

I am writing with regard to a consultation process that we have undertaken about proposed changes to the time of our school day from September 3rd, 2018.

The Governing Body met on Tuesday, May 22nd to consider all of the responses received as part of the consultation from parents, carers, students and staff. They would like to acknowledge and state their appreciation for the time taken in expressing an opinion. The changes proposed were as follows;

School day from Monday September 3rd, 2018

8.35am	Warning bell
8.40 – 9.00am	Registration
9.00 - 10.00am	Lesson 1
10.00 - 11.00am	Lesson 2
11.00 - 11.20am	Break
11.20 - 12.20pm	Lesson 3
12.20 - 1.20pm	Lesson 4
1.20 - 1.50pm	Lunch
1.50pm	Warning bell
1.55 – 2.55pm	Lesson 5
2.55pm	End of school day

After full consideration for all the points raised, the Governors have unanimously made the decision to change the times of the school day from September 3rd, 2018 to those above. This decision also took account of the significant investment by the Local Authority in our canteen provision which will greatly improve the quality and efficiency of our service from September.

There is obviously no impact on home to school transport in the morning but parents / carers should note that from September the school day will finish 10 minutes earlier at 2.55pm.

My thanks again for all of your comments and engagement through this consultation process.
