Dear Parent / Carer,

On Thursday, October 11th the School Governors met to discuss all of the proposals for the reorganisation of our School over the next 4 years. By the end of the meeting all governors reached an overall agreement on the school position based on all information available.

In the next two weeks I will be meeting with local councillors and politicians to discuss their views so that our response to the consultation process covers all aspects of the proposed plan. In addition, Governors want to make sure that the views of all parents and carers are included as part of our response. Whilst a meeting has been planned next January with the Local Authority we believe another meeting is necessary to discuss all details. **As such we would like to invite you to a meeting in the School Main Hall on Monday, November 19th at 6.30pm.**

Senior staff and governors will be present to go through the school position in relation to the proposals for reorganisation. There will be an opportunity for you to express your opinion and for us to answer questions or clarify information. It is the intention that by the end of the meeting, everyone is in a position where they can complete a well-informed response to the consultation process.

Your child will be bringing home a letter from the Local Authority which outlines details of the consultation process and a link to the document itself.
