



Home Learning - Guidance for Pupils

From January 4th 2021 all pupils (apart from the most vulnerable and key worker children in years 7 and 8) will be working from home. **It is crucial that you complete all work set to the best of your ability.**

Your work each day will follow the timetable on the school website. All tasks will be set on **ClassCharts**. The work for the day will be available from **8.30 am each morning.**

Each day you should start work by **logging into ClassCharts** and reading carefully through the tasks that have been set. Your teachers will have written down clear instructions that will include details of the **deadline** and **method of submission** for each task. You may find that your teacher has uploaded **documents/links** for you to access directly onto **ClassCharts**. You will also have access to a range of recorded lessons.

From **ClassCharts** you may be directed to a number of digital platforms (**see digital platforms box**) that best suit the work set.

You may occasionally be added to **live lessons using Microsoft Teams**. If this is the case your teacher will send you an invitation to the lesson **by email.**

Please remember to **check** your **school email account every day** for important information whilst you are away from school.

What if I need help?

If you are having any difficulties with home learning it is important that you **ask for help.**
