## **Progress**

We're currently in week 12 and there has been good progress on the new school building in the past month. The structural openings for the new windows and doors have been formed and the existing structure of timber and steel has been strengthened to allow the repurposing of the space for a state of the art primary provision. We've also introduced foundations to allow for a sliding partition wall to Nursery and Reception classrooms and a roller shutter to the servery from the new kitchen.

In the coming weeks we will be starting on the M&E first fix in readiness for the partitions in the new year. We'll also be demolishing the old Caretakers house to allow for new parking provision. The formation of bus parking area will also be started.
