Progress

Another good month of progress and another month closer to completion. The external areas are coming together with the road down to the rugby fields nearing completion and another carpark has been opened for the school. The retaining wall to form the external areas has been completed and the foundations for the canopies have been poured. The final windows and doors have been put in place giving the envelope of the building a colourful look.

Internally the walls are up and we're well underway with the mechanical and electrical installation ready to bring the building to life.

The scaffold to the Sports Hall is ongoing, this will allow us to install the Photo Voltaic panels to the roof which is part of the Net Zero Carbon ethos of the new school.

The 3G pitch is also gathering pace with the last stone trim to make sure the whole area is level. Then the tarmac layer and carpet can be laid.

School Engagement

We had yet more visitors from Cilfynydd Primary with years 3 and 4 coming to site to have a look around, making sure we're doing a good job.

Finally, we've got a local young person on site gaining work experience as he wants to get into the construction industry. He is currently on a 4 week placement with us, experiencing all elements of the construction trades.


